REGISTRATION:

DEADLINE: August 24, 2009

Bring the form to the August 6, 2009 meeting OR mail the form to Janet Alexander at the address below* OR give the form to any committee member named below. Please respect the deadline since show floor design depends on the information you give us on the form.

"PRIORITY NUMBERS" EXPLAINED: You are being asked to prioritize your entries so that if there are too many entries received to fit onto our show floor, your favorites can be chosen to be in the show. We have always been able to find space for nearly all entries, but in years past, entries were limited to three per member. Fill out entry forms for as many quilts as you like, but *prioritize* your entries (i.e. #1, #2, #3 etc). You will be notified if any of your entries are cut due to space limitations. Your Challenge Quilt entry won't need a priority number.

ENTRY RULES

Exhibitors are to be ASQG Members ONLY. Our show space does not allow us the privilege of asking for submissions outside our Guild.

No previously shown articles

Please call a Registration Co-chair if you wish to exhibit a quilt not made or owned by you. Contact information is above.

All articles/Quilts must contain:

- Label attached to the back, which includes the name, address, and phone number of exhibitor.
- Quilts must have a 4-inch wide sleeve sewn along the top on the reverse side.
- Quilts must be submitted in a pillowcase, also marked with the name, address, and phone number of exhibitor.
- You must complete a separate registration form for each item with a Priority #. (In the event of a shortage of space, your highest priority quilts will be chosen.)

READY, SET, SHOW: Please be sure that your quilt entries are "show ready". They must be clean, free of animal hair and smoke odors. Follow the instruction above for labeling and adding a sleeve.
